Welcome to the 63rd Annual Brush Rodeo and Parade!!

Please return the attached entry form and \$10 fee (non-profits exempt) to the Brush Chamber office by 4pm on Friday, June 30th to be eligible for judging. Plan to be present, registered and pick up your entry number at the registration booth by 9:30am on the 4th. **If you do not want to be judged, there is no entry fee.** The parade will start at 10am on Tuesday, July 4 at the Brush High School parking lot (enter on north side of high school, see map).

The parade will leave the Brush High School parking lot on Centre Ave. going South 2 blocks to Edmunds, then going East to Cameron St. **Due to construction on Mill Street this year, the parade will go north on Cameron past the library to Howard, west to Turner and then north back to Mill Street.** Judging will be done at Library Park.

Parade participants will need to enter the Brush High School parking lot from the north side of the school off of Mill Street or Hospital Road (see attached map). If you are dropping off participants, please enter through the Parade Drop Off Entry. Non-participant vehicles dropping people off, will not be allowed in the Parade Line Up area (large parking lot).

Participants who need to park horse trailers, please unload at the Ackley Building Center parking lot off of Mill Street. Horse riders may ride through the Parade Line Up to get to their staging area (see map).

Shriners will line up in the Methodist Church parking lot (see map) and come down Eaton Street to enter the parade.

We ask you to abide by the following rule: **Throwing candy or other items from moving vehicles or floats is strictly prohibited.** Individuals on foot may pass out candy or other items. Outriders or walkers are to be provided for all draft horse teams, mule or horse drawn floats or wagons. Two-wheel motor cross bikes or motorcycles are prohibited from doing “wheelies” during the parade.
